## Roles of the Board of Governors

The Board of Governors is the highest decision making body of SIESCOMS. The Board plays a crucial role in the institutes' governance but not in its routine management. The day-to-day management of SIESCOMS is executed by the Director, faculty and administrative staff. The management of the college does, however, conform to the policies and guidelines set and established by the Board of Governors.

The Board of Governors is constituted as per the norms of AICTE and it includes individuals from diverse backgrounds whose combined expertise proves invaluable in policy implementation and making decisions in the best overall interest of the institution, and in support of the vision and mission of SIESCOMS

The Board shall meet atleast once or twice a year. However, the Board will meet anytime during terms to discuss and resolve important and urgent matters.

### Roles & Responsibilities

- To ensure that the Institute's policies, procedures and standards are in keeping with the guidelines set by accreditation bodies.
- To help the SIESCOMS liaises with stakeholders and to ensure that internal liaison between the Board and the various committees, staff and students of the college is effective.
- In conjunction with the nominee of the President of the Society, provide advice, guidance and support to SIESCOMS and its officers to ensure the successful delivery of the institute's mission.
- Responsible for reviewing and approving all policies and procedures.
- Receives and review half-yearly report from Quality Improvement Committee.
- Receives and review half-yearly report from Quality Assurance Committee.
- Helps to promote the institute's public image to members of the community.
- Helps the college to achieve its strategic objective by its advocacy and deliberation at Board of Governors meetings.
- To review and approve the institute's mission and vision statement, strategizing direction and overall goals and objectives.
- To receive and approve the institute's quality assurance policies and systems.
- To ensure that the college complies with all statutory regulatory requirements.
- To approve all new academic programmes or accreditations pursued by the college.

The composition of the Board will be as per the norms recommended by AICTE which includes the following:

The Governing Body shall have at least eleven members including the Chairman and the Member Secretary. The Registered Trust/ Society/ Company shall nominate six members including the Chairman and the Member Secretary, and the remaining five members shall be nominated as indicated below.
