On 25th of February 2024 evening, 26 students from different courses [MMS, MCA] from SIES College of Management Studies along with one faculty left for the Global Immersion Program from Mumbai International Airport.

Day 1:

Upon arrival to Dubai on the following Monday morning the 26th of February, the group headed to its first Industrial Visit to Redington, the second largest distributor of IT products in India, a renowned B2B distribution multinational corporation.

The group was fascinated to see their work efficiency as upon receiving an order, the invoicing and documentation are done within the 1st hour and packing and logistical arrangements for delivery are done within the following 2-3 hours. They usually achieve their target time because they deliver

mostly by Air and seldom by Sea. Almost 60% of their orders are from outside of UAE, 35% are from within UAE and the remaining 5% are delivered directly to the customers. Their sister companies Pro Connect & Endure are the top players in logistics and service sectors respectively. The students got the opportunity to visit their warehouse and understood their operations and the different software & technologies used by them. In the evening, the group went to Desert Safari and then headed to the hotel.

Day 2:

On the 27th of February, the team was scheduled to visit Dabur International's manufacturing plant. Here the focus centered on understanding their stringent quality assurance protocols, notably in maintaining precise water levels in products such as shampoos and toothpaste. The students were impressed by the batch production sizes ranging from 1000 to 4000 kilograms for shampoos, underscoring Dabur's commitment to scale and efficiency in manufacturing.

A range of products were produced in this plant like toothpaste, mouthwash, hair cream, hair gel, handwash, and shampoo. We got to see the types of machinery and equipment closely and understood the operations and functions of the same. Students were instructed to wear hair nets, masks, and shoe covers while entering these production stations exhibiting Dabur's high hygiene standards.

As a gesture of hospitality, the Dabur team graciously distributed samples of their products, allowing the students to experience firsthand the quality and innovation synonymous with the brand. In the evening, they got the opportunity to ride the cruise and were astonished by the alluring and elegant structures of Dubai.



Day 3:

Continuing our educational odyssey, the group had the privilege of visiting Bolton University in Ras-Al-Khaimah, where they delved into the dynamic educational landscape of the UAE. The university's comprehensive presentation illuminated the diverse range of courses offered, including insightful

details about their prestigious top-up MBA programs, enriching our understanding of academic opportunities in the region.
